# Mike Hellweg Miniature Livebearers

This talk covers many of the truly tiny Livebearing species that are popular in the hobby, and many that are less common including many of the diminutive Poecilia, "Micropoecilia", Girardinus, Gambusia, Heterandria, Neoheterandria and several others. In this talk, guppies are the giants! It covers some of these amazing fishes' specialized adaptations to meet the challenges of delivering live young when the females are often not a whole lot larger; husbandry, feeding and much more. "Miniature Livebearers" was recently given to the Chicago Livebearers Association.

**About Mike:** Mike's Profile was in the last Darter issue. Local and surrounding Aquarium Society members know Mike as Auctioneer and source of information and hard to get fish for their tanks. Mike was just named the first "Tremendousest Grand master Breeder" for MASI with over 6500 points in our BAP program. He has had successful spawns from various miniature fishes totaling over 400 species from 32 families of fish including more than 125 livebearer species. He credits his success to large regular water changes, keeping live plants in every tank and culturing and feeding an assortment of live foods daily for feeding his breeding stock and for growing the fry of these diverse fish.



Mike has given nearly 300 talks to classes, clubs, groups and conventions all over the USA and Canada, has documented many of these keeping and spawning successes in more than 250 articles published in hobby publications around the world, and has had two books on live foods published by TFH Publications.

breeding 25 different fish in one year, out of all the fish spawned that year, the Corydoras paleatus were by far the most fun. Three years later he has more than 80 types of Corydoradinae fish in his home and likely qualifies as an addict of some sort!
